Mixing Bowl

Mixing Bowl is an open community where we creatively explore spirituality and what Christian faith, art and community looks like outside of the traditional church context. Join us for a meal and to creatively engage on the themes of the SAW artistic programme, delving deeper into the meaning and significance behind the artwork and giving time for reflection or prayer. This term we explore the creative practices of Mixing Bowl members, paralleling the 'Take Over' theme in our exhibition to explore how their practice helps them understand the world or supported their spiritual life.

Shieldfield Wheatfield

We are excited to announce the next development in the urban food-growing project with artist Mikey Tomkins that began in summer 2019. After talking with participants and residents after his mapping workshops the feedback was that there was a curiosity to actually grow some food in Shieldfield. So we are growing wheat in Shieldfield that will harvest 10kg of flour, which we will use to bake around 10 community loaves to share at a Shieldfield harvest event in September 2020. There are many different aspects that you can get involved in such as building planters, the sowing and growing, harvesting and threshing, baking and eating.
